Value

The Saskatchewan Chapter of the Association of Certified Fraud Examiners will award two scholarships valued at \$500.00 each to two Saskatchewan High School students.

Eligibility

Students in grades 9 to 12 attending a Saskatchewan High School are eligible upon submission of an essay in their own words outlining how to protect their family, friends, community, and themselves from one of the following fraud schemes:

- 1. Ponzi scheme**
- 2. Advance fee for service scheme**
- 3. Nigerian letter or “419” fraud**

Your essay* must be type-processed in English and should be limited to no more than three to four pages (type-processed, double-spaced). Considerable emphasis will be placed by the judges on the content, grammar and the syntax. Please include your name, your grade, and the name of your school.

To be considered for the scholarship, your essay must be submitted by midnight May 11, 2012 at the following address:
